HEALTH FOCUS WITH DR. HAZEL MARKWELL Autonomy & Choice: How Assisted Suicide and Euthanasia Changes Everything

Dr. Markwell will offer insights and reflections from her experience as Executive Director of the Centre for Clinical Ethics in Toronto, and now from her current role as Ethics Consultant for the Catholic Health Alliance of Canada.

Anne Butler, RN, MSN, ANP-BC, ACHPN is the Executive Director and Founder of Interior by Design Associates: Cultivating Wholeheartedness in Healthcare. Anne is a national healthcare consultant, board certified Adult Nurse Practitioner with a specialty in Geriatrics and Palliative Medicine, a certified Courage and Renewal

Facilitator through the Center for Courage and Renewal, a certified Leadership Coach from the Institute of Transformational Leadership at Georgetown University, a graduate of the Harvard Medical School Palliative Care Education and Practice certificate program and the Center for Narrative Practice certificate program, Massachusetts Medical Society. Anne's thirty plus years of dedicated clinical practice span from the patient bedside to the corporate boardroom to the international refugee camp and beyond.

The Beauty of the Song: Embracing the Vulnerability of Others

There is both science and art to our caregiving, inviting us to open first ourselves in order to tend properly to the vulnerability in another. It is an inside-out dance; a counter-intuitive dance in the midst of numerous external realities that suggest we view vulnerability as weakness and beauty as glamorous. These mixed messages and competing priorities can leave us isolated and divided. And yet our faith, our mission, invites us to courageously embrace our own vulnerability and that of another, in exchange for that Divine Breath that gently opens our heart to receive love, to experience compassion and to live out of our hopes rather than our fears. As God's beloved, we are awakened to our innate capacity to transform our pain and become wounded healers.



KEYNOTE ADDRESS: DR. JOSEPHINE LOMBARDI

Dr. Lombardi has worked as a parish minister, university campus minister, high school chaplaincy leader, teacher educator through O.E.C.T.A., professor of Religious Educationn at Brock University, retreat facilitator, faith formation consultant, and program coordinator in the Diocese of Hamilton. Presently, she is Associate Professor

of Pastoral and Systematic Theology, Professor of Field Education, and Director of Lay Formation for St. Augustine's Seminary in Scarborough, Ontario. She has done media work in radio and television and has been an advisor to the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops in the area of doctrine and Catholic-Muslim relations. Her books On Earth as it is in Heaven and Experts in Humanity have been featured on Salt and Light TV. More recently, she has been appointed Series Theologian for the new Religious Education curriculum for grades 1 through 8, "Growing in Faith, Growing in Christ" for Catholic School Boards in Ontario, Alberta and Saskatchewan.

Mercy and Beyond: Understanding the Obstacles that Keep Us from Being Merciful Witnesses

In the her first session, Josephine Lombardi will examine factors that harm the formation of conscience and weaken a person's ability to reason and to understand consequences. We will look at prenatal, postnatal, genetic and environmental factors. The presentation will conclude with a focus on God's grace as the greatest influence on the human person's ability to respond to God's will. The following session will explore the deeper meaning of mercy and the obstacles that keep us from being God's instruments of mercy.
