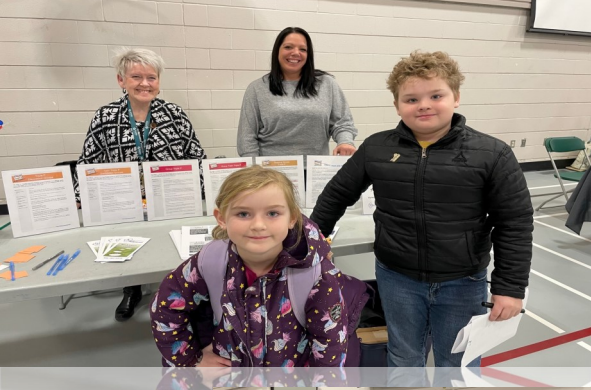


Wellness Fairs
