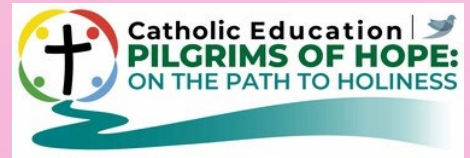
The Prince Albert Catholic School Division is proud of the students and staff and therefore the Board of Education would like to highlight different elements that make our educational faith community distinct.

Did You Know... the Saskatchewan Roughriders visited several schools in the Division to present on Mental Health and Wellness. 

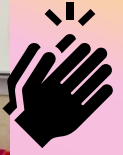




We continue to accept registrations for 2026-2027
